ABSTRACT

- 1. Last half century has seen profound changes in the field of international relations. Several strategically important nations have gained prominence in the geo politics of Indian Ocean Region (IOR). These nations have become increasingly relevant over the time. Sri Lanka is one such country that has gained immense geo-strategic and geo political importance in the last decade or so. According to The Prime Minister of Sri Lanka Ranil Wikramsinghe, the political interplay in the Indian Ocean is in danger of becoming a major centre of tension. A power struggle in the Indian Ocean will no doubt also adversely affect Sri Lanka's objective of becoming the hub of the Indian Ocean. Sri Lanka's future prosperity depends on the stability of the Indian Ocean. A power struggle in the Indian Ocean also risks making the littoral states into spectators in the Indian Ocean.
